**RE: NEW VACCINE, TB AND STI MEDICATION  
INVENTORY SYSTEM AT HKPR – COMING JUNE 2015!**

On June 15, 2015 the HKPR District Health Unit will be implementing **PANORAMA INVENTORY**, a provincial web-based electronic system that helps to better manage vaccine, TB and STI medication distribution and inventory.

*How will this change affect you?*

- Vaccine/medication orders will **NOT** be processed from **June 8<sup>th</sup> up to and including June 19<sup>th</sup>, 2015**. The Health Unit will resume processing orders on June 22<sup>nd</sup>, 2015.
- There will be new forms for ordering vaccines and medications (see Sample for the Port Hope office).
- A packing slip will be attached to each vaccine and medication order you submit.
- Routine vaccine pick-up and delivery days *may* change.
