ATTENTION PHARMACIES

Vaccine fridge logbook temperatures are to be faxed to the Health Unit **every Tuesday** between 8:30 and 4:30. (submit ONLY on Tuesdays. Logbook temperatures faxed on other days will not be accepted.)

For pharmacies that do not submit temperatures on Tuesdays: vaccine distributors will be notified and flu vaccine delivery will be suspended for one week.

Please remember to stamp your logbook temperatures with the name and address of your pharmacy and ensure your pharmacy is clearly identified. The Health Unit has received temperatures from unknown pharmacies. This may result in unnecessary suspensions.

Should you require further information, please contact the Health Unit and ask to speak with a Vaccine Preventable Disease Nurse in the Communicable Disease Control, Epidemiology and Evaluation Department
