Proportion of adults (18+) who received flu shot during most recent flu season, who live with, or visit high-risk individuals with at least once a week (i.e. persons with chronic conditions or persons over 65+ years), RRFSS January - April 2007

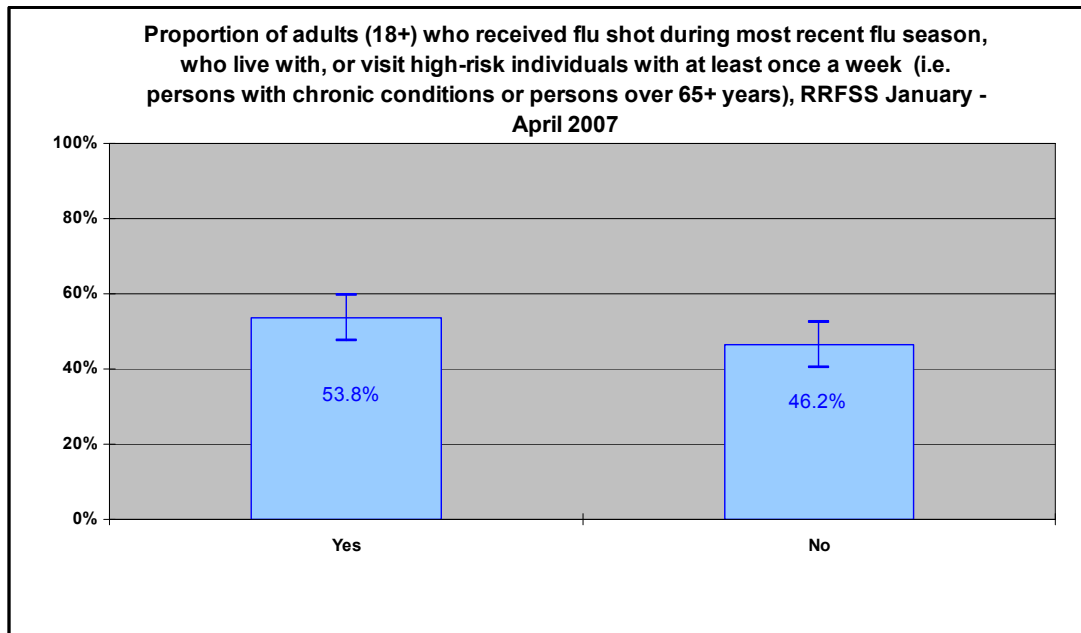

**Figure 1: Flu Immunization (live/visit with high-risk individuals)**



**Interpretation:**

53.8% (+/-6%) of adults (18+) who live with or visit with at least once a week individuals with a chronic health condition and/or who are 65 years of age or older reported that they received a flu shot since September 2006 (for the 2006-2007 flu season).

46.2% (+/-6%) of adults (18+) who live with or visit with at least once a week individuals with a chronic health condition and/or who are 65 years of age or older reported that they did not receive a flu shot since September 2006 (for the 2006-2007 flu season).

**Limitations:**

1. Questions only asked of adult residents aged 18+.
2. Telephone survey only conducted in English.
3. Results are based on self-reported behaviours.
4. (\*) indicates that results are based on small sample size, thus estimates have high variability.

- 1) The numbers in the tables and graphs are weighted.
  - 2) Missing responses are not included in the analysis.
  - 3) Don't know and refused responses are analyzed according to RRFSS analysis guideline.
