

Section 6 Overview of HKPR District Health and Social Infrastructure

1. Population

HKPR District consists of Northumberland County, City of Kawartha Lakes and Haliburton County and has a population of 171,671 (2006 census)

2. Health Care Organizations

Hospitals

There are four acute care facilities in HKPR District: The Northumberland Hills Hospital located in Cobourg; Campbellford Memorial Hospital located in Campbellford; Ross Memorial Hospital located in Lindsay; and Haliburton Highlands Health Services in Haliburton and its branch in Minden. Table 6.2 provides an overview of each of these facilities.

Central East Community Care Access Centre

The Central East Community Care Access Centre (CCAC) organizes home care and placement in long term care facilities for the residents of HKPR District residents. There are four offices in the health unit catchment area: Port Hope; Campbellford; Lindsay; and Haliburton. Table 6.3 provides contact information and the average number of clients served by CCAC.

Long Term Care Homes (LTCHs)

There are 30 Long-Term Care/Retirements Facilities in HKPR District.

16 of these facilities are solely nursing homes, 4 consist of both a nursing home and retirement home, and 9 are solely retirement homes. There are a total of

2065 beds in these facilities. Table 6.4 provides an overview of each of these facilities (Note: Some facilities information is not available).

Pharmacies

There are approximately 39 pharmacies in HKPR District. A list of pharmacies with locations and contact information is provided in Appendix 11.4

Dentists

There are approximately 55 dentists in HKPR District. Appendix 11.4 provides a list of dentists contact information and location.

Veterinarians

Key contacts to assist with animal related outbreaks include the Ontario Ministry of Agriculture, Food and Rural Affairs (OMAFRA), the Ministry of Natural Resources (MNR) and the Canadian Food Inspection Agency (CFIA). Contact information for these organizations is provided in “**HKPRDHU Emergency Response Plan in the Event of an Outbreak of Avian Influenza in Domestic Poultry**”

There are approximately 29 vet services in HKPR District. Their contact information is provided in Appendix 11.4.

3. Essential Services

Police Services:

HKPR District has 3 local police services; the Municipality of Port Hope Police Service (905- 885 8123), the town of Cobourg Police Service (905- 372 2243) and the City of Kawartha Lakes Police Service¹ (705- 324 6307).

The Central Region Ontario Provincial Police (OPP) detachments serve the remainder of the district. Refer to Appendix 11.4 for location and detachment commander information.

Ambulance Services

There are 3 Emergency Medical Services in HKPR District. Appendix 11.4 provides contact names and capacity of each service.

Funeral Services

There are 18 funeral homes and 1 crematorium in HKPR District. Refer to Appendix 11.4 for contact information.

4. Educational and Child Care Institutions

Post-Secondary Institutions

Fleming College is the only post secondary institution in HKPR District with campuses in Cobourg, Lindsay and Haliburton. Lindsay campus provides an on-campus student residence. Appendix 11.4 provides contact information and the number of students at each campus including the Lindsay student residence.

Schools

Publicly funded schools within HKPR District fall under the Peterborough Victoria Northumberland and Clarington Catholic District School Board (705 - 748 4861), the Kawartha Pine Ridge District School Board (705-742 9773) and the Trillium Lakelands District School Board (705 – 324 6776). There are 128 Elementary Schools and 24 Secondary School in HKPR District in addition to several private institutions.

A list of all schools, their enrolment and contact information is provided in Appendix 11.4.

Day Care Centers

There is a total of 31 licensed childcare facilities in HKPR District. Appendix 11.4 provides a list of the childcare facilities, enrolment and contact information. Aside from licensed child care facilities, there are numerous unlicensed, family child care centers for which detailed information is not available.

5. Other Facilities

Group Homes:

There are numerous group homes or other sorts of organized group living arrangements in HKPR District. Appendix 11.4 provides a list of group homes and shelters, the number of residents that can be accommodated and contact information.

Correctional facilities:

There is one provincial correctional facility in Lindsay (CKL), one Federal correctional facility in Warkworth (Northumberland) and one provincial youth detention center in Cobourg.

Table 6.5 provides a brief overview of these detention centres.

Essential Municipal Services:

Essential municipal services required to keep the local infrastructure functioning consist of people who provide hydroelectric power, water treatment, sewage treatment and natural gas. It is the responsibility of each municipality to keep an up to date list of their essential workers and maintain their own Business Continuity Plan.

Workplaces:

Most workplaces in HKPR District are medium size. A list of some major workplaces, approximate number of employees and contact information is provided in Appendix 11.4 for surveillance purposes

Decision Makers:

Key decision makers consist of elected politicians and key bureaucrats in the City of Kawartha Lakes, at the county level (Northumberland and Haliburton Counties), and within local municipalities in Northumberland and Haliburton Counties.
