



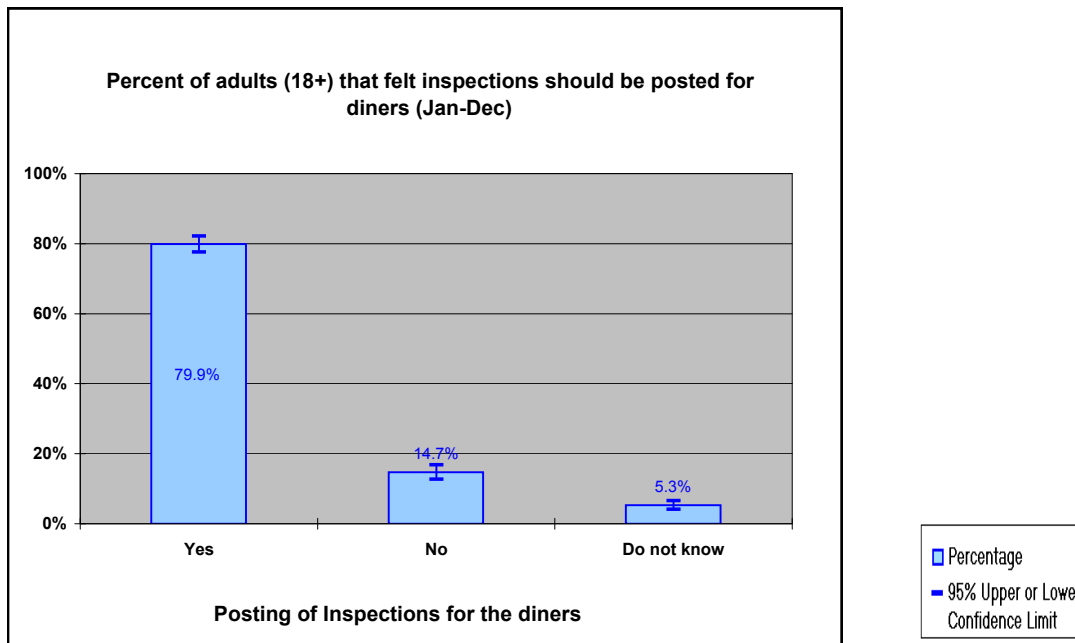
Rapid Risk Factor Surveillance System

Haliburton, Kawartha, Pine Ridge District Health Unit RRFSS 2006 (Jan-Dec) - Food Safety

Percent of adults (18+) that felt inspections should be posted for diners (Jan-Dec)

Inspections should be posted for diners	Proportion	95% upper confidence limit	95% lower confidence limit
Yes	79.9%	82.2%	77.6%
No	14.7%	16.8%	12.7%
Do not know	5.3%	6.6%	4.1%

Sample size: 1193



Interpretation:

- 79.9% (+/-2.3%) adults (age 18+) said that inspections should be posted for the diners
- 14.7% (+/-2.0%) adults (age 18+) said that inspections should not be posted for the diners
- 5.3% (+/-1.3%) adults (age 18+) refused/did not answer

Limitations:

1. Questions only asked of adult residents aged 18+
2. Telephone survey only conducted in English
3. Results are based on self-reported behaviors.
4. (*) indicates that results are based on small sample size, thus estimates have high variability.

Notes:

- 1) The numbers in the tables and graphs are weighted.
- 2) Missing responses are not included in the analysis.
- 3) Don't know and refused responses are analyzed according to RRFSS analysis guideline.
- 4) Release criteria of the data is according to RRFSS analysis guideline.
