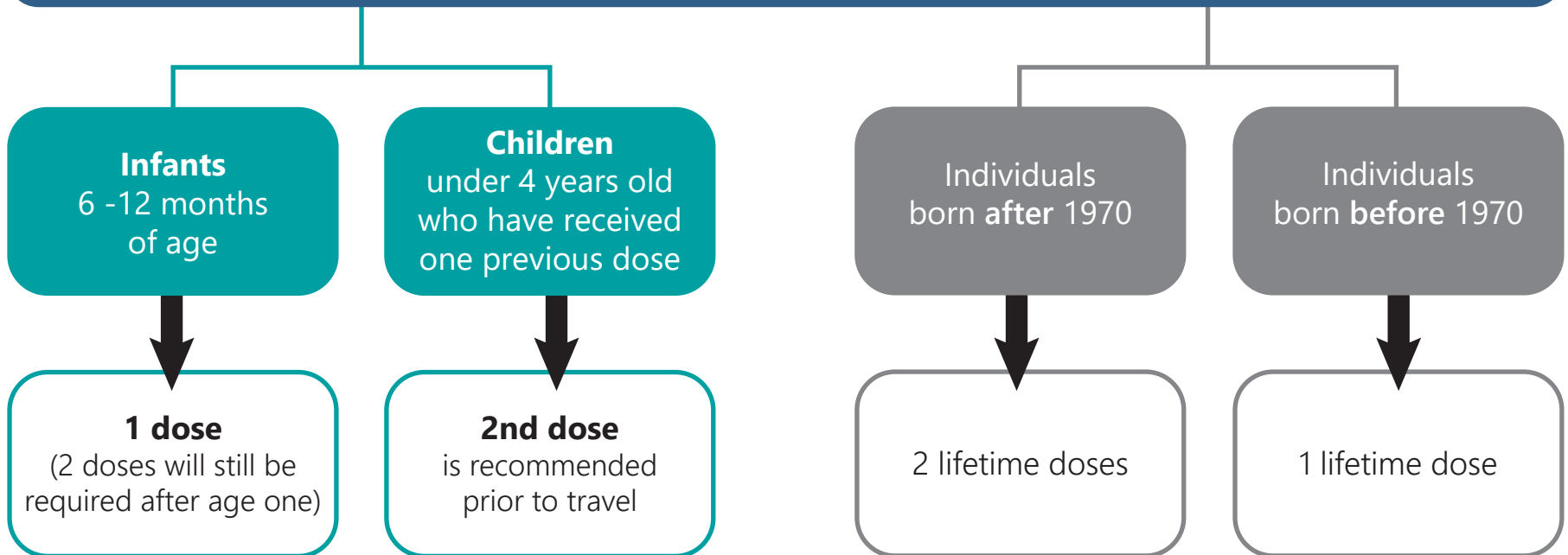


HIGH RISK MMR VACCINATION FLOWCHART

MMR vaccination is recommended for travellers, health care workers, post secondary students, and anyone (based on doctor's judgement) UNLESS there is lab evidence of immunity or history of lab confirmed measles. Vaccination is recommended over serological testing.

For Travellers

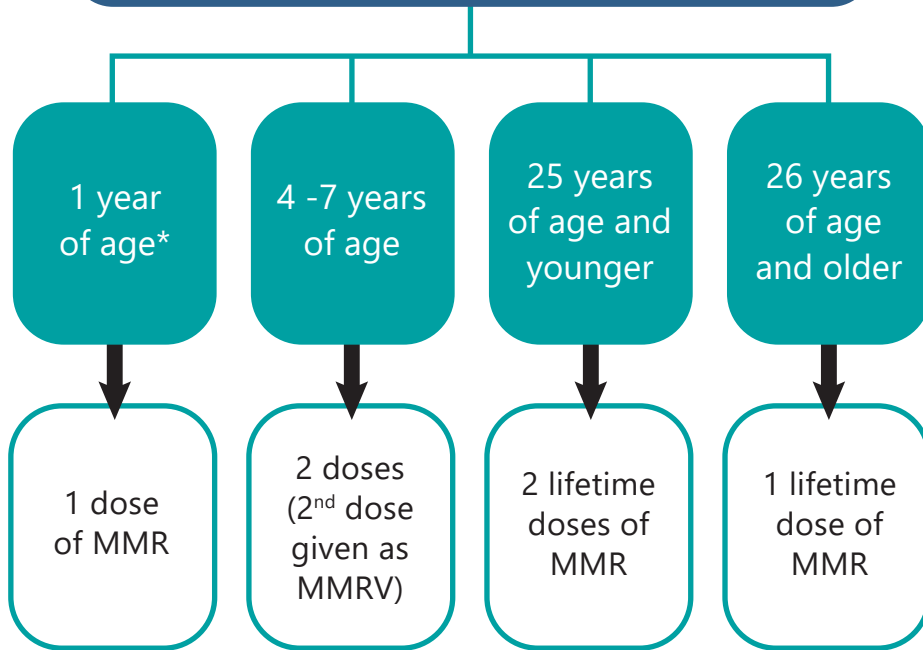


For Health care workers, post secondary students and anyone (based on doctor's judgement)

2 lifetime doses of MMR
irrespective of age or date of birth

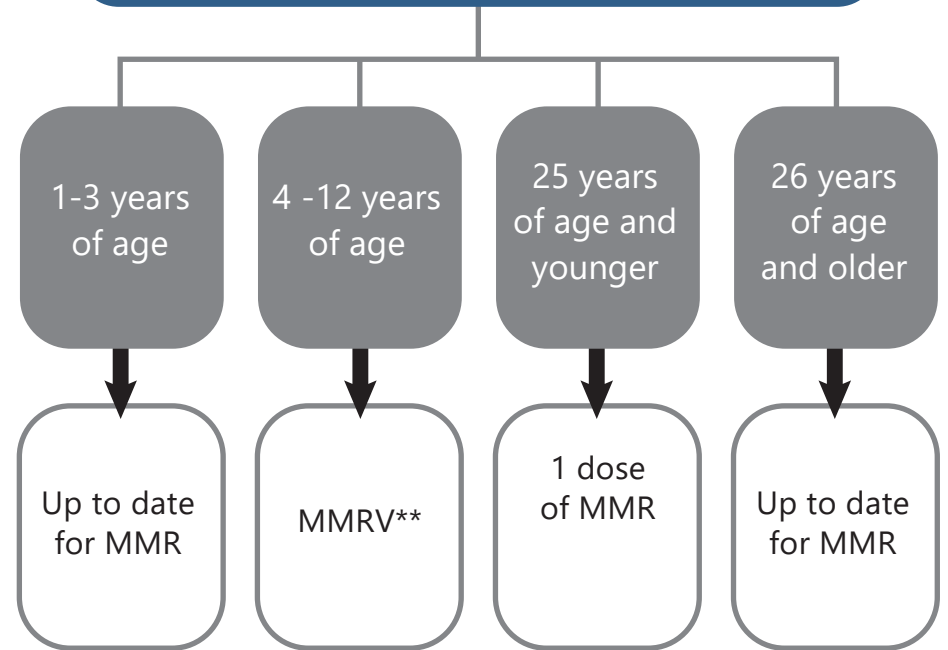
ROUTINE MMR VACCINATION FLOWCHART

*Early Administration of MMR in Pediatric Populations: MMR may be given as early as 6 months of age if deemed high risk but, still require 2 doses after 1 year of age.

History of 1 dose of MMR



**MMRV can only be given to children 4-12 years of age
